

# Participate in a Housing Study



## Who can participate?

You can participate if your situation is one of the following:

- (1) You have moved into a community/public housing unit for the first time in the last 30 days.
- (2) You have been approved for the Rent Assistance Benefit (RAB) or the Temporary Rent Assistance Benefit (TRAB) in the last 30 days.

## What does it involve?

- You will complete 3 surveys over one year, either by phone or online.
- You will be compensated with a gift card for each survey.
- You will be asked questions about your experiences with housing, any discrimination you may have faced, and your overall health and well-being.
- Your personal information will not be shared and participation in the study will not impact your housing assistance

## Why should I participate?

- You will be contributing to research about the experiences and quality of life for people accessing housing assistance.
- These research findings will be shared with housing service providers and policy makers.

## What is the goal of this study?

We are trying to learn more about:

- How housing assistance impacts individual's housing experiences and quality of life.
- How this impact might differ for people receiving different types of housing assistance.
